Important points

- Undertake further specialist postgraduate training to develop career aspirations in dermatology with an emphasis on clinical skills as well as the scientific, evidence base underpinning contemporary dermatology practice.
- The normal entry requirements for the programme are:
 1. A degree in a healthcare discipline (or equivalent) & be registered with a professional and statutory body
 2. The equivalent of 2 years Full Time post-qualifying experience (excluding internship) including a minimum of 6 months Full Time (or equivalent) in a substantive speciality post in dermatology (primary or secondary care) prior to programme commencement
 3. All students from non-majority English speaking countries require proof of English language proficiency. A minimum IELTS 6.5 is required with no less than 6.0 in each band, or GCSE English with a minimum of grade C.

Academic Year

Academic Year 2021 – 2022

The University's academic year is made up of 3 Semesters.
