- You will work alongside practitioners working in a range of areas of practice, in a stimulating and challenging environment.
- You will exhibit in the in-house PG Art gallery space and externally once a year.
- You will gain advanced technical and entrepreneurial skills for the successful creative practitioner.

Academic Year 2021 – 2022
